Summer Worship Schedule. The Congregation Council has approved a motion from the Executive Committee establishing a new Worship Schedule for the summer of 2016. Beginning next Sunday, June 5 and extending through Sunday, August 14, Trinity will worship at 8:15 am and 10:00 am. Both services will feature traditional liturgies and be held in the Sanctuary. A fellowship time for all ages to include refreshments will be held between the services in the Assembly Room and Parlor. The Church Office will be open from 9:00 to 9:55 am during the summer. On Sunday, August 21 the regular schedule that includes services at 7:45, 9:00, and 11:15 am will resume. This adjusted summer worship schedule will provide a wonderful opportunity for folks to adjust their schedules and worship with a variety of Trinity members and guests.

Parking Lot Management. Trinity has entered into an agreement with Lanier Parking to manage all of Trinity's parking lots. Active TLC member households will need to register their vehicles through the Church Office. Upon registration each vehicle in the household will receive a parking permit to place on the inside front windshield on the driver's side. During the week, TLC members with a permit may park in any space in the parking lots that are not numbered. Please stop by the Church Office during our office hours of 8:30 to 4:30 Monday through Friday and 8:30 to 11:00 on Sunday mornings to register your vehicles. The information needed to register is the make, model, year, and color of the vehicle, as well as the license tag number.
