The quilts are made for Lutheran World Relief to send to countries ravaged by war or natural disasters for use as bedding, for warmth, shelter, and carrying possessions. The Loving Threads ministry crochets and knits prayer shawls for persons who struggle with loneliness, illness, grief or pain. Bandages are made for victims of leprosy in Vietnam. Baby blankets are given in times of joy and celebration at the birth or adoption of a child.
