Children and Youth

LCY - Today, 6:00 pm, Youth Center. After dinner, youth will play Bunco in the Youth Center.

Halloween Carnival - Sunday, October 29, 5:00 to 6:30 pm, Gym. Trinity families of all ages are invited to attend LCY's annual Halloween Carnival. A hot dog and french fry meal will be available for purchase (\$3.00 for one meal, \$5.00 for two meals). Children must be accompanied by an adult. All are encouraged to come in costume.

Safe Sitter - Saturday, November 4, 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Trinity is now a registered Safe Sitter training site. Trinity youth who wish to volunteer in the Church Nursery must be Safe Sitter certified as well as trained in Trinity's Child Protection Policy. The cost is \$25.00 per person, which covers the training materials and a light lunch. Trinity members Rachel Balck, Terry Batts and Cathie Landreth are the instructors. Youth who wish to attend the November 4 training must sign up through the Church Office no later than Sunday, October 29.

Middle Schoolers at the Soup Kitchen - Sunday, November 5, 9:00 am. Youth in grades 6 through 8 will staff Project Host Soup Kitchen. Youth need to be dropped off at the Soup Kitchen by 9:00 am and picked up at 12:45 pm. Spots are limited and are on a first come, first served basis. Youth must sign up no later than Sunday, October 29. Trinity adults will be at the Soup Kitchen to provide supervision. Sign up is through the Church Office.

Education

Sunday School - Today, 10:10 am. Sunday School is offered for all ages every Sunday between the 9:00 and 11:15 am services. Preschoolers (infants through children under the age of four) may attend the *First Faith* class with their parents. A nursery is also available. Children's Sunday School for those who were four or five on September 1 meets on the first floor of the Education Building, across from the elevator. Children in grades 1 through 5 meet in *Grace Place*, upstairs in the Education Building. Youth Sunday School for middle and high school students meets in the Youth Center. Meeting as separate groups, youth will enjoy "pick up" breakfast items, games, fellowship and devotions in a new format for this school year.

Adult Sunday School always begins with Coffee and Conversation in the Multipurpose Room beginning at 9:50 am. There are currently four adult classes begin offered. The class *Right Click: Parenting Your Teen in a Digital Media World* is a class recommended for parents of children of any age. This class is exploring and discussing issues related to digital media including cell phone usage, gaming and social media, as well as setting limits, bullying and responsibility. A second class is called *Wearing God*. Based on the book by Lauren F. Winner, this class delves into overlooked ways of meeting God. The third class is *Reformation Through the Lens of Scripture*. This class is studying texts and hymns related to the Reformation and Martin Luther. The final class is entitled *What Does It Mean to be a Lutheran?* This six week class is designed for those who are exploring the possibility of joining Trinity, and examines the Christian faith from a Lutheran perspective.

My First Bible - next Sunday, October 15, 2:00 to 3:30 pm, Multipurpose Room. Third graders and their parents are invited to attend a special event called *My First Bible*. This event, planned by the Education Committee, will be a time for parents and children to explore the Bible together and talk about what it means. The afternoon will include various stations and games, and a chance for parents to inscribe and present a Bible to their child. Children in grades 4 and 5 who have not previously attended are also invited to attend. Parents may register through the Church Office by Sunday, October 8.
