Extend kindness to the cashier at the grocery store, the teller at the bank, the barista at Starbucks, the person sitting next to you in the pew at church, the neighbor living next door to you, our neighbors at Towers East, the hungry and homeless folks in our community, the people in our lives who work tirelessly to support their families and still struggle to make ends meet.

Every single person is struggling with a heavy burden. Share the love of Christ with the world by extending kindness to all people.

## VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL

Trinity's 2018 Vacation Bible School will be July 23 through 27, from 8:45 am to noon, for children who will be aged 3 by September 1, 2018 through those who have recently completed Grade 5. 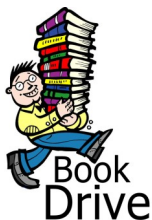
