Trinity's Vacation Bible School begins tomorrow, from 8:45 am to noon each morning. Parents and staff should park in the upper lot by the Red Canopy Door or the Playground lot. Each morning will begin with a devotion and worship experience in the Multipurpose Room. Parents are welcome to attend devotions with their children. As a part of worship, children are invited to bring an offering each day to go along with the theme. On Monday, non-perishable food items will be collected. On Tuesday, school supplies; on Wednesday, first aid items; on Thursday, new, twin sized flat sheets, any color except white and cream; and on Friday, pet food will be collected. The week will conclude at noon on Friday with a picnic in the Activities Building.

Summer Sunday School - Today, 10:10 am. Summer Sunday School will be offered for all ages every Sunday this summer. Preschoolers (infants through children who have not completed K5) are invited to the Nursery. Elementary aged children (those who have completed K5 through grade 5) will meet in one combined class on the first floor of the Pence Education Building.
