Dear Members of the Trinity Family,

In an effort to care for our family of faith and to prevent the spread of coronavirus in the larger community, the leadership at Trinity made the decision this morning to cancel all on-site groups, meetings, and events including Wednesday Lenten activities as well as all off-site gatherings (G.I.F.T. groups, etc.) effective immediately and continuing through Friday, March 27 when the situation will be reevaluated. The only exception is the bagged lunch and food bag distribution to our neighbors at Towers East planned for tomorrow at 11:00 am.

Next Sunday, March 22 at 10:00 am a livestream service from the Sanctuary will be provided. In person attendance by members and friends of the congregation is strongly discouraged. We encourage everyone to livestream.

During this time of fear and uncertainty I encourage each of you to connect with Trinity members and friends. Pick up the phone and call someone. Send a text. Address a card. Write a note. Please be especially mindful of members and friends who might be feeling very isolated during this time. Let's be a comfort and support to one another. Please reach out to the Church Office if there is a need of which we should be aware.

The ministry that we do together at Trinity is vital to the community. During this time of absence from one another, I ask that you continue supporting this ministry with your offerings and prayers. Gifts may be made online through our website or checks mailed to the Church Office

These are challenging, unsettling days for all of us. Take comfort in the words of Joshua 1:9 that say, "Be strong and courageous, do not be frightened or dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." I am continuing to hold each of you close in my heart and in my prayers.
