God said to Moses at the burning bush, "Come no closer! Remove the sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground." Exodus 3:5

Dear Members of the Trinity family,

Looking back over this past year there have been many times when I was aware that I was standing on holy ground. Holy ground moments are those times and spaces in life when the curtain between the ordinary and the extraordinary is lifted and we see with new eyes. It's those times when we recognize the sacred in our midst, the times when we have clarity of vision, a sense of peace, evidence that God is in our midst, that God is cheering us on. During holy ground moments we know that we are not alone, that God is taking past hurts and old wounds and bringing healing, wholeness, life, reconciliation, and meaning.

I have experienced these holy ground moments at the bedside of a dying parishioner, around my family's dinner table, on a Zoom call with a beloved colleague, visiting with our neighbors at Towers East, gathered with friends around the firepit in our backyard, early mornings spent with God in prayer and meditation, preaching a sermon that I knew was challenging and unpopular, a front porch visit at my home with two youth members of Trinity, and discovering new, meaningful, surprising relationships that are bringing joy and light.

During these months of pandemic life, when have you found yourself standing on holy ground? How have you experienced God's presence in these chaotic times? How has God revealed God's self to you? When have you felt closest to God? During Lent several members of our congregation will be answering these questions through meditations that will be included in our weekly mid-week Lenten services. It will be a time for us to be challenged, encouraged, strengthened, and sustained by the stories and experiences of our siblings in Christ at Trinity. I look forward to sharing these worship experiences with you. Keep an open mind and heart to God's presence and be expectant for those moments when God invites you to stand on holy ground.

- ---authorized Terry Morgan to be added as an additional person to sign checks in 2021;
- ---registered Trinity member, Pastor Donald Miller, for candidacy in the SC Synod of the ELCA:
- ---affirmed the following meeting schedule for 2021: February 21, March 14, April 18, May 23, August 15, September 12, October 10, November 14, and December 12; and
- ---noted that council members and officers will be installed at worship on Sunday, January 31

#### TRINITY LUTHERAN FOUNDATION GRANTS

The Trinity Lutheran Church Foundation Committee met in December to consider grant applications for 2020. Thirteen grants totaling \$100,000 were awarded to the following recipients:

- Center for Developmental Services \$9,800 for operating funds to support services during the pandemic.
- Evangelical Lutheran Church in America \$10,000 to support the International Women Leaders program.
- Greenville Homeless Alliance \$7,500 to help establish an Advocacy Training Academy.
- Lutheran Homes of South Carolina Foundation \$5,000 to help fund hospice care for low income patients in Greenville and the surrounding areas.
- Novus Way \$10,000 to provide a COVID 19 grant to help sustain the ministry.
- Pendleton Place \$8,000 to provide funding for comprehensive "step-down" housing for young adults aging out of foster care.
- Pride Link \$5,000 to help launch a Host House Program for youth in the LBGTQ+ community.
- South Carolina Lutheran Retreat Centers \$8,000 to replace an HVAC unit at Camp Kinard and provide a COVID 19 grant to help sustain the ministry.
- Sustaining Way \$5,000 to support the Steward Youth Program in the Nicholtown Community.
- The Family Effect \$10,000 to purchase supplies for the program for Infants and Children at Serenity Place.
- The Homeless Period Project \$5,000 to help fund period packs for women and girls in need in Greenville.
- Trinity Lutheran Church \$8,700 to support a revisioned version of Trinity's Nourishing Neighbors food ministry.
- United Ministries \$8,000 to provide rent on three apartments for homeless people.
