## **COUNCIL NOTES**

At the March meeting of the Congregation Council, the council...

- ---noted that expenses for February were \$6,993 less than projected;
- ---received a report from Pastor Parham on the progress of the organ rebuild project noting that the organ builder anticipates installing one of the chests as early as June;
- ---received a report from Pastor Crowell on the progress of the columbarium project noting that, contingent upon weather, the project could be complete as early as the end of May;
- ---received a report from Trinity's COVID-19 Transition Team; and
- ---unanimously approved a motion from the Executive Committee to host a student from Trinity Seminary, an ELCA seminary in Columbus, Ohio, for an extended pastoral internship beginning in the fall of 2021. Details will be shared with the congregation when more information is available.
