Dear Members of the Trinity Family,

During Epiphany we remember the arrival of the magi who came from afar to pay homage to the Christ child. These magi followed the light of a star, the brilliant light that led them to the infant Jesus. The season of Epiphany is a season of light - starlight, moonlight, sunlight, lamplight, firelight, candlelight, even leftover Christmas lights. It's a season to banish the darkness, the sometimes cloudy, gloomy, lonely, frigid cold darkness of winter. In an effort to banish the darkness, I will light lots and lots of candles...in the kitchen, in the den, in the family room, on the dinner table, even in the bathroom. Light some candles and as you light each one, remember that Jesus is the light of the world, the light no darkness can overcome. May the Christ child born for you at Christmas bring love and light into our lives during this Epiphany season.

COUNCIL NOTES

At their December meeting the Congregation Council...

- welcomed newly elected members Calvin Harmon, Amy Hegarty, John Otten, Jimmy Reynolds, Peggy Schotsch, and Roger Brown;
- celebrated the strong financial year that 2021 has been thus far and noted that expenses for November were \$22,052 less than projected;
- received a report from Trinity's COVID19 Transition Team;
- voted to register Patrick Preacher for candidacy in the South Carolina Synod of the ELCA and to partner with him as he plans to begin his seminary education in the fall of 2022;
- designated housing allowances for both Pastor Parham and Pastor Crowell;
- authorized the Executive Committee with support from staff to appoint 2022 Committees and Lay Assistants (which will happen in mid-January);
- appointed Richard Moose to serve as the Treasurer and elected Donna Potts to serve as the Vice-President and Heather Kleckley to serve as the Secretary in 2022;
- noted that the next council meeting will take place on Sunday, January 9 at 1:30 pm and that council members will be installed during worship at 10:00 am that morning; and
- expressed gratitude to outgoing council members for their faithful service and leadership to include Valerie Hollinger, Ryan Koon, Angie McCormack, Merry Mulcahy, Franklin Sease, and Campbell Balck.

Trinity's Covid-19 Transition Team is recommending and requesting that masks be worn by all during worship. 8:30 AM WORSHIP EXPERIMENT

As the worship needs of the congregation continue to be evaluated, the Trinity family will experiment with a second service at 8:30 am on January 9, the Baptism of Our Lord Sunday. This 8:30 service will be very similar to the 10:00 service and will include Holy Communion, but will likely be a smaller, more intimate service and might be much more comfortable for those who have been hesitant to return to in person worship due to the ongoing risk of COVID. The Trinity family will also gather in the Sanctuary for worship at 10:00 am. The 10:00 am service will be livestreamed. This 8:30 service will only occur on January 9 as the expectation is to explore and evaluate several worship times before a more permanent Sunday morning worship schedule is set.

NURSERY FOR SUNDAY MORNING WORSHIP

A nursery is available during the 10:00 am worship service on Sunday morning. Practices and protocols follow all DHEC recommendations for daycare centers. All staff and volunteers must be fully vaccinated and wear masks at all times. A copy of the updated guidelines can be obtained through the Church Office. The age requirements for children in the nursery are flexible and fluid during this time of transition.

FAITH FORMATION

TLC KIDS, a learning program for preschoolers and elementary schoolers, meets in person from 9:15 to 9:45 am in the Multipurpose Room. Parents can attend with their children, and those K5 and above, including all adults, will be masked. This time together includes singing and dancing (with our Bible School video), Bible stories and videos, and crafts. We end in time for families to attend in-person worship at 10:00 am.

YOUTH FAITH FORUM will meet on Sundays, January 9, 16, and 23, at 9:00 am in Room 14 of the Activities Building. This gathering for youth in Grades 6 through 12 will include time for sharing and fellowship, as well as discussion of current events and Bible Study. It will end in time for participants to attend worship at 10:00 am.

PARENTS FAITH FORUM will meet on Sundays at 9:00 am on January 9, 16, and 23 in Rooms 12 and 13 of the Activities Building. This group is intended for parents of our middle and high school youth to have a time to enjoy fellowship and topical based discussions. It will end in time for participants to attend worship at 10:00 am.

ADULT FAITH FORUM is a group that meets on Zoom on Sunday mornings from 8:00 to 9:00 am. Conversation begins at 8:00 am, with the discussion beginning at 8:15 am. All adults are welcome to participate. This group discusses current events in light of our faith as Christians. The Zoom link is emailed out on Fridays to those interested by Deacon Amy Brown, and is also included in the Friday worship email everyone receives. Ending at 9:00 am allows those worshipping in person time to drive to the church, and those worshipping at home time to prepare for at home worship.

QUEER LED WORSHIP: TAIZÉ AROUND THE CROSS




