Labyrinth

Throughout the Lenten season a labyrinth is available in the Multipurpose Room for the Trinity family and friends to use as part of a Lenten prayer and meditation practice. A labyrinth is an ancient walking meditation device used by Christians to induce or enhance a meditative state of mind. It is a spiritual tool which can clear the mind, calm anxieties, reduce stress, guide healing, enhance creativity, and lead to personal growth.

Lenten Prayer Cross

Throughout the Lenten season, a prayer cross is being used during Sunday worship services. In-person Sunday worshippers are invited to arrive in time to write down a prayer request on a provided note card. Worshippers will then place their prayer on the cross before worship. Everyone is encouraged to include one's name and cell number on the prayer card so that one might receive an uplifting text from the person who is offering the prayer. Upon leaving worship, worshippers will be asked to take a prayer off the cross (not your own), include the prayer request in your prayers the coming week, and let the person know you are praying for them by sending an encouraging text. Dear Members of the Trinity Family,

On Labor Day weekend in 2021 I attended the Wild Goose Festival in Hot Springs, NC, a gathering of faithful people from around the country and throughout the world who are passionate about Jesus, social justice, diversity, and inclusion. This three-day gathering was a time to embrace and celebrate God's love for all people and a time to be fed, nourished, and refreshed in a community of kindred spirits.

The festival includes dozens of opportunities to gather for lectures, discussions, and shared learning. There are always new ideas that challenge my thinking and mindset. This festival was no different.

I reluctantly agreed to accompany my family to an afternoon worship experience being led by a drag queen. To be completely transparent, I did not want to attend. Up until that point my experience with drag queens was limited to the drag queens I had seen at the Red Party, an annual event in Greenville sponsored by Aid Upstate, and my limited exposure to RuPaul's Drag Race. My expectations were so low that I did not even bother to pull out my notebook and pen to take notes. I incorrectly assumed that the Lady Douché had little to teach me. I was very wrong.

I sat in the front row and tried to put on a brave, interested face. From the beginning the Lady Douché was funny, engaging, clever, and inviting. She slowly chipped away at my disinterest. But, it was her sermon that completely disarmed me. She preached the most beautiful, theologically astute, and profound sermon that I have ever heard on the story of Jesus and the woman at the well. I was mesmerized by her thoughtful and engaging message and kept wishing I had my pen and notebook to record her words.

I left the Wild Goose Festival eager to share the wit and wisdom of the Lady Douché with our Trinity family. I am delighted that the Lady Douché has accepted our invitation to present "Drag Me to Church" at Trinity on Thursday, May 12 at 7:00 pm in the Gym. This presentation is being funded by a generous grant from the Growing in God's Mission Fund of the South Carolina Synod of the ELCA. If attending a drag show is a stretch for you, if you are hesitant or uncomfortable about attending, I encourage you to set your fears aside, reach beyond your comfort zone, and make plans to join our Trinity family, queer friends in the community, and allies for this special performance. I am certain that you will be glad you came.
