Dear Members of the Trinity Family,

On Ash Wednesday, March 2, with Christians around the world, we begin the forty-day journey of Lent that leads to the death and resurrection of Christ. Traditionally the Lenten season is a somber, reflective time when followers of Christ adopt new spiritual practices, release old, unhelpful habits, or give up specific foods, practices, or activities in an effort to foster healing, wholeness, as well as physical, emotional, or spiritual health. Taking on new practices or letting go of harmful habits can certainly be helpful, but perhaps this might be the year for us to consider a different approach to Lent.

My colleagues and I invite you to consider reading Kate Bowler and Jessica Ritchie's book entitled Good Enough: 40ish Devotions for a Life of Imperfection as part of your Lenten discipline. Given the challenges, burdens, losses, and difficulties of the past two years of pandemic living, perhaps this is the year to practice Lent in a way that is "Good Enough," a way that extends love, kindness, and compassion to ourselves and others. Perhaps this is not the year to give up caffeine, alcohol, chocolate, dessert, or any of the parts of life that bring us joy. Perhaps this is not the Lent to train for a marathon, take on a demanding practice, or work for radical change in our lives. Perhaps this is the Lent for self-acceptance, for self-love, for mutual caregiving. Perhaps this is the Lent, the season of our lives, when we practice grace...grace toward ourselves and grace toward others. Perhaps this is the Lent for surviving, not thriving; the Lent for rest, renewal, and stillness. Perhaps this Lent can be about less, rather than more. Perhaps this is the year that we settle for a Lent that is good enough.

When planning for Lent 2022 at Trinity, I was hoping for a Lent that could be both meaningful and manageable. Within this newsletter, you will find some options for how you can observe Lent. Some are tried and true options that include worship, study, and collecting items for those in need in our community. Others are new to us like spending time at church walking the labyrinth. Some are easy - reading a devotional email delivered to your inbox each day - and others require more effort - attending weekly Wednesday evening worship services. Let's do Lent together, and let's do it in a way that brings life and healing, not judgment or rejection or negativity. Let's make plans for a Lenten season that is "Good Enough!"

## NURSERY FOR SUNDAY MORNING WORSHIP

A nursery is available during the 10:00 am worship service on Sunday morning. Practices and protocols follow all DHEC recommendations for daycare centers. All staff and volunteers must be fully vaccinated and wear masks at all times. A copy of the updated guidelines can be obtained through the Church Office. The age requirements for children in the nursery are flexible and fluid during this time of transition.

## FAITH FORMATION

TLC KIDS, a learning program for preschoolers and elementary schoolers, meets on Zoom from 9:15 to 9:45 am on Sunday mornings. This time together includes Bible stories and videos. We end in time for families to attend on-line worship at 10:00 am.

YOUTH FAITH FORUM will meet on Sundays at 9:00 am in March in Room 14 of the Activities Building. This gathering for youth in Grades 6 through 12 will include time for sharing and fellowship, as well as discussion of current events and Bible Study. It will end in time for youth participants to attend in-person worship at 10:00 am.

PARENTS FAITH FORUM will meet on Sundays at 9:00 am in March in Rooms 12 and 13 of the Activities Building. This group is intended for parents of our middle and high school youth to have a time to enjoy fellowship and topical based discussions. It will end in time for participants to attend in-person worship at 10:00 am.

ADULT FAITH FORUM is a group that meets on Zoom on Sunday mornings from 8:00 to 9:00 am. Conversation begins at 8:00 am, with the discussion beginning at 8:15 am. All adults are welcome to participate. This group discusses current events in light of the Christian Faith. The Zoom link is emailed out on Fridays to those interested by Deacon Amy Brown, and is also included in the Friday worship email everyone receives. Ending at 9:00 am allows those worshipping in person time to drive to the church, and those worshipping at home time to prepare for at home worship.

## COLLECTION FOR REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT


Trinity is collecting items to create hygiene kits for Afghan refugees being resettled in Greenville through Lutheran Services of the Carolinas. Items needed include:

## LENT 2022 AT TRINITY

### **Ash Wednesday Worship**

An Ash Wednesday Service that includes the Imposition of Ashes and Holy Communion will be held in the Gym on Wednesday, March 2 at 6:15 pm. This service will also be livestreamed. Ashes are available in the Church Office for those who plan to worship remotely.

### **Weekly Wednesday Worship**

Each Wednesday during the Lenten Season (March 9, March 16, March 23, March 30, and April 6) at 6:15 pm Holden Evening Prayer with a meditation based on the book Good Enough: 40ish Devotions for a Life of Imperfection will be held. Location for service will be announced closer to date depending upon the ceiling repair work in the Sanctuary. These services will also be livestreamed.

### **Congregational Lenten Book**

Members and friends of the congregation are invited to read Good Enough: 40ish Devotions for a Life of Imperfection by Kate Bowler and Jessica Ritchie during the Lenten season. Readers are invited to consider the weight of perfection in our lives which includes the pressure to be healthier, wealthier, more accomplished, more balanced, and more grounded. The authors invite readers to focus less on perfection and more on the simple knowledge that all are loved. Copies can be purchased online or from a local bookseller. ### **Reflection Opportunities for Lenten Book**

### **Labyrinth**

Throughout the Lenten season a labyrinth will be available in the Multipurpose Room for the Trinity family and friends to use as part of a Lenten prayer and meditation practice. A labyrinth is an ancient walking meditation device used by Christians to induce or enhance a meditative state of mind. It is a spiritual tool which can clear the mind, calm anxieties, reduce stress, guide healing, enhance creativity, and lead to personal growth. The labyrinth will be available for use Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, on Wednesday evenings from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm and on Sunday mornings from 9:00 am to 11:00 am.

### **Lenten Prayer Cross**

A new church season provides new opportunities for spiritual growth and connection. Throughout the Lenten season, a prayer cross will be erected for Sunday worship services. In-person Sunday worshippers are invited to arrive in time to write down a prayer request on a provided note card. Worshippers will then place their prayer on the cross before worship. Everyone is encouraged to include one's name and cell number on the prayer card so that one might receive an uplifting text from the person who is offering the prayer. Upon leaving worship, worshippers will be asked to take a prayer off the cross (not your own), include the prayer request in your prayers the coming week, and let the person know you are praying for them by sending an encouraging text. Online worshippers may email their weekly prayer request to Patrick Preacher ([pdp preacher@trinitylutheran.ws](mailto:pdp preacher@trinitylutheran.ws)) to be included in this meaningful Lenten discipline.
