**A "New to Us" Spiritual Practice.** A labyrinth is a spiritual tool that can be used for prayer, meditation, calm, and connection with God. To use it, simply follow the path into the center, pause, and retrace the same path back again. A labyrinth is NOT a maze. There are no dead ends. The Labyrinth journey consists of three stages: releasing as you start toward the center, receiving as you pause there, and returning as you journey back out. The labyrinth in our Multipurpose Room is on loan to us from Holy Cross Episcopal Church in Simpsonville, SC. You are invited to walk the labyrinth on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings during Lent when we are open for worship, and during the weekdays when the Church Office is open from 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. Please try and arrive by 4:00 pm.

**Lenten Prayer Cross.** Throughout the Lenten season, in-person Sunday worshippers are invited to arrive in time to write down a prayer request on a provided note card. Worshippers will then place their prayer on the cross before or during worship. Everyone is encouraged to include one's name and cell number on the prayer card so that one might receive an uplifting text from the person who is offering the prayer. Upon leaving worship, worshippers will be asked to take a prayer off the cross (not your own), include the prayer request in your prayers the coming week, and let the person know you are praying for them by sending an encouraging text.
