Dear Members of the Trinity Family,

When I was in college I spent several summers serving as a camp counselor at Lutheridge. Lutheridge has always been my happy place! Those summers spent at camp surrounded by the beauty and majesty of God's creation and living in intentional Christian community had a profound impact on my life and played a significant role in helping me discern a call to pastoral ministry.

I have a vivid memory of claiming this verse from 2 Corinthians 5:7 as my favorite passage of scripture and of crafting a banner to illustrate why this passage was so meaningful to me. The passage reminds me of the many "trust walks" that my fellow counselors and I took together. Assigned to teams of two - one person blindfolded and the other one seeing - the blindfolded one trusted the other to lead and guide them on a trail around camp. Those experiences helped me to walk in faith even when I could not see.

As a community of faith we find ourselves in a similar place. So much is changing in our world and in our beloved congregation. There is so much we do not know, so much of the future we cannot see. And yet, we trust. We have faith. We hold tight to the promise that God is holding our hands, leading us along the path, constantly making a way for us. While the future is unknown to us, it is known to God. God has always made a way for me. God has always - even in times of war, crisis, conflict, sickness, and fear - made a way for this congregation. This has been true for one hundred and thirteen years since Trinity was organized in 1909. It is still true now. God is making a way for us. Let us trust that even in the darkness, even when we cannot see, God is leading us into a beautiful future.

COUNCIL NOTES

At the August meeting of the Congregation Council, the council...

---learned that expenses for July were \$2,142 more than expected and that expenses for the first seven months of 2022 are \$9,113 more than budgeted;

---received an update on the progress of the organ rebuild project noting that due to supply chain issues the instrument will not be completed in 2022;

---learned that through December, 2023 Safe Harbor is occupying space in the back portion of the 429 North Main property due to asbestos and mold issues in the front portion of the building;

---learned that Greenville's new justice organization will be called GOAL (Greenville Organized for Accountable Leadership) and Trinity Team leaders for this ministry include Elizabeth Allen, Penny Bostain, Paige Dillon, Lane Lewis, Angie McCormack, and Missy Roberts;

---received a report from the Worship Committee that the congregation will continue to worship at 10:00 am each Sunday, alternating between the Gym and the Sanctuary, at least through the end of 2022; and

---received an update on youth and children's ministry noting that youth activities were held twice monthly throughout the summer and that the hope is to hold two youth events per month occurring on Sundays following worship for the remainder of the calendar year.





The Enneagram is a tool that allows us to form a deeper understanding of ourselves and others. The more we understand ourselves, the more equipped we are to respond in a positive way to those with whom we are in relationship.


