FIRST READING


2 Kings 2:1-12

A reading from second Kings.

¹Now when GOD was about to take Elijah up to heaven by a whirlwind, Elijah and Elisha were on their way from Gilgal. ²Elijah said to Elisha, "Stay here; for GOD has sent me as far as Bethel." But Elisha said, "As GOD lives, and as you yourself live, I will not leave you." So they went down to Bethel. ³The company of prophets who were in Bethel came out to Elisha, and said to him, "Do you know that today GOD will take your master away from you?" And Elisha said, "Yes, I know; keep silent." 4Elijah said to him, "Elisha, stay here; for GOD has sent me to Jericho." But Elisha said, "As GOD lives, and as you yourself live, I will not leave you." So they came to Jericho. ⁵The company of prophets who were at Jericho drew near to Elisha, and said to him, "Do you know that today GOD will take your master away from you?" And Elisha answered, "Yes, I know; be silent." ⁶Then Elijah said to Elisha, "Stay here; for GOD has sent me to the Jordan." But Elisha said, "As GOD lives, and as you yourself live, I will not leave you." So the two of them went on. 7Fifty of the company of prophets also went, and stood at some distance from them, as they both were standing by the Jordan. ⁸Then Elijah took his mantle and rolled it up, and struck the water; the water was parted to the one side and to the other, until the two of them crossed on dry ground. ⁹When they had crossed, Elijah said to Elisha, "Tell me what I may do for you, before I am taken from you." Elisha said, "Please let me inherit a double share of your spirit." ¹⁰Elijah responded, "You have asked a hard thing; yet, if you see me as I am being taken from you, it will be granted you; if not, it will not." ¹¹As they continued walking and talking, a chariot of fire and horses of fire separated the two of them, and Elijah ascended in a whirlwind into heaven. ¹²Elisha kept watching and crying out, "Father, father! The chariots of Israel and its horsemen!" But when Elisha could no longer see him, Elisha grasped his own clothes and tore them in two pieces.

The Lord is with you.




