**Period Party.** In celebration of the end of the Pink Tax in South Carolina, let's have a Period Party on Thursday, June 13 at 2:00 pm in the Assembly Room to pack period packs for local women and girls living in poverty who do not have access to feminine hygiene products. Participants are encouraged to bring tampons, pads, and liners for the project. Refreshments will be provided. This event is open to women, men, and children and is being hosted by Caroline Otten, Pastor Crowell, and Patrick Preacher. Please reach out to the Church Office to register for this event.

**Feminine Hygiene Product Collection.** In preparation for the Period Party on Thursday, June 13, feminine hygiene items are being collected (tampons, pads, and liners) to create Period Packs for local women and girls living in poverty.
