Children's Worship Activity. Accompanied by Child Protection trained adults, children are invited to leave worship after the children's sermon to go hear the scripture read in ways more appropriate for their age. Using lectionary stories heard in worship each Sunday, the children not only hear scripture, but enjoy a related activity such as a game, craft, or music. Children return to worship during the sharing of the peace and in time to participate in the celebration of Holy Communion.

Procession with Palms today. All children are invited to meet in the back corner of the Gym, ten minutes prior to worship, to participate in the Procession with Palms. At the end of the procession, children will sit with their parents.
